#### Training Details

##### (Description of post)

This post is suitable for those who wish to further develop their practice in orthodontics and undertake training to consultant level. The post offers a broad experience of all aspects of orthodontics and provides an exciting opportunity to develop and enhance the services provided to the local community. Duties include both clinic and theatre sessions, and involvement in teaching and mentoring more junior staff.

The post holder is expected to treat a range of patients in accordance with departmental guidelines. The post holder will be encouraged to develop their clinical skills and progress in the post, taking on increasingly complex patients and caseload. Whilst service delivery is important, contributions to the wider Trust in fields such as audit, outcomes, research management and teaching will be encouraged.

## **Description of main training site**

Whipps Cross University Hospital is an NHS Hospital in Waltham Forest, North East London serving a local population of more than 350,000 people. It is part of Barts Health NHS Trust which was created on 1st April 2012 following the merger of Barts and The London NHS Trust, Newham University Hospital NHS Trust and Whipps Cross University Hospital NHS Trust. The area served is vibrant and diverse with a wide variation of levels of health needs.

The Orthodontic Department is adjacent to the Oral Maxillo-facial Surgery Department, with which it shares many facilities. The Department has a dedicated polyclinic, which includes three dental units and a fourth separate clinic. There is a separate sterilising area, junior staff office / planning area, laboratory, model store, staff room, waiting area and offices.

The Department provides a full range of contemporary Orthodontic techniques and adopts an interdisciplinary approach to patient care. Regular Combined Clinics are held with Oral and Maxillo-facial Surgery and there is access to the many services available at the Royal London Hospital with which we are merged.

There is a dedicated postgraduate dental conference, teaching and training area in close proximity to the Department. Whipps Cross Hospital also has a very active postgraduate Medical Education Centre.

### **Description of second training site**

The Department of Orthodontics forms part of King's Dental Services, working in partnership with Dental Services at Guy's & St Thomas' and the Dental School of King's College London. The partnership provides services at multiple locations which are principally at King's and Guy's University Dental Hospitals. The orthodontic department is situated over two sites, the Denmark Hill site at King's College Dental Hospital and Queen Mary's Hospital, Sidcup.

The orthodontic service provision forms part of the Trust's Clinical Service in Dentistry. In an average year, approximately 2,700 new patients are referred to the department and 15,000 patients attend the department, on an outpatient basis, for treatment. Currently, only those patients who warrant hospital orthodontic care (rated as having an Index of Orthodontic Treatment Need grade 4 or grade 5) are accepted for treatment within the department. Many patients require input from other specialists as part of their care, namely Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Restorative and Paediatric Dentistry.

The department is situated on the 1st floor of King's College Dental Hospital. It comprises 18 dental chairs in an open clinic and 1 fully equipped enclosed side surgery, for the delivery of dental care. 5 dental chairs on the main clinic are used for undergraduate teaching and learning.
